



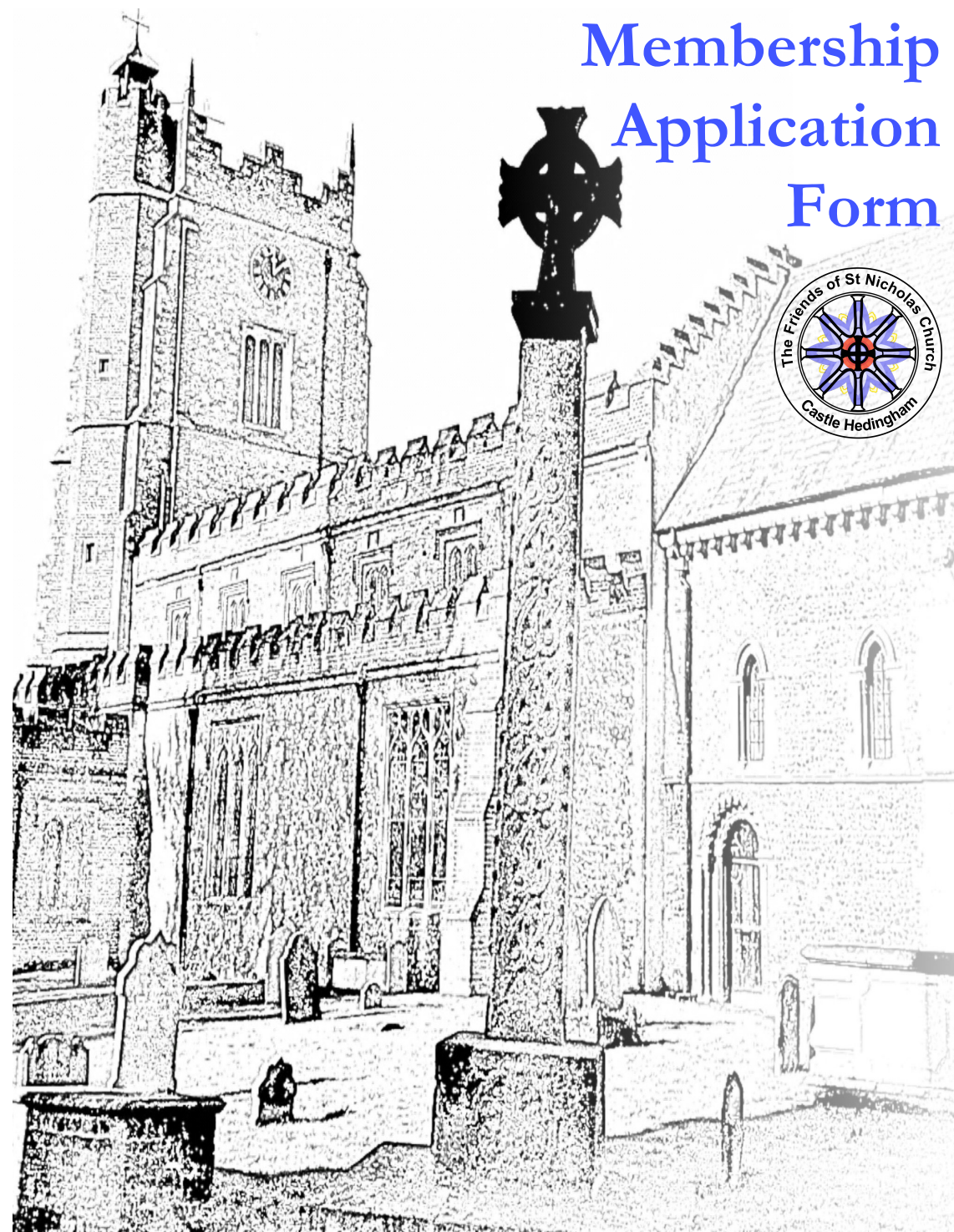
St Nicholas Church in Castle Hedingham is probably one of the most historically important churches in East Anglia.

A Grade 1 Listed Building dating back to the 12th Century, initially built and thereafter patronised by the de Vere family, Earls of Oxford whose castle still towers over the village. More than one hundred years after the Norman elevations of the church were built the 3rd Earl of Oxford appended his seal to Magna Carta.
